To all students wishing to apply:

- 1. You must be a resident of Ocean County.
- 2. The closing deadline date is March 28, 2025 4 pm at the office. Documents must be received by mail or hand delivered by this deadline
- 3. A scholarship is available **only** if student's major is in horticulture or related fields. Examples of related fields are agricultural science, natural resource management, landscape architecture/design, forestry, turf grass science, plant science, greenhouse management, aquatic botany, plant ecology, soil science or environmental science.
- 4. Explain your reasons for pursuing an education in horticulture or related fields (attach additional sheets as necessary - more information is better than less) on the scholarship application. Successful applicants provide one or more paragraphs.
- 5. We primarily communicate via e-mail, so please check the e-mail listed on your application in case we need more information or would like to schedule an interview.
- 6. While not required, it is recommended that you submit a resume along with your application.

These documents are needed to have your application considered:

- 1. 2025 Master Gardener of Ocean County Inc. Scholarship Application
- 2. Official SAT scores (required) and AP scores (if applicable)
- 3. Official School transcripts
- 4. **TWO** letters of recommendation

If your application is not complete in every aspect, it will not be considered.
